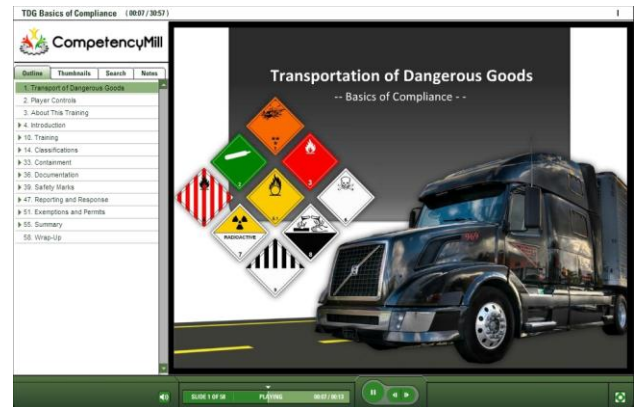


About this Training Program
